IV. PLAN REVIEW REQUIRED

Plans must be submitted with an Application for Plan Examination and the appropriate deposit before a permit can be issued, except as listed below.

Plans are not required for the following:

1. One and two family dwelling containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area.
2. Alterations and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be of a minor nature.
3. Buildings with a required plumbing fixture count less than 12.
4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00

Plans are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act 1980 PA No. 299, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature.

V. * APPLICANT SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the state construction code act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. Violators of section 23a are subjected to civil fines.

* Note: Special Airport Zoning Height restrictions may apply in your particular area. Please be advised if you are planning on using tall cranes, etc., as part of your project. You may need approval of the Federal Aviation Administration.

VI. HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT

All work shall be installed in accordance with the State Plumbing code and shall not be enclosed, covered up, or put into operation until it has been inspected and approved by the State Plumbing Inspector. I will cooperate with the State Plumbing Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections.

VII. FEE CLARIFICATIONS

ITEM #2, MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE: WHEN item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. WHEN setting a mobile home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

ITEM #21, DOMESTIC WATER TREATMENT AND FILTERING EQUIPMENT: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed, and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #21 for \$5.00 each, and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

ITEM #22, MEDICAL GAS SYSTEMS shall include the application fee, one Medical Gas System Fee #22, and the estimated number of additional inspections in #24.

IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

Make Checks Payable to: CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FLINT

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Flint Township Building Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
