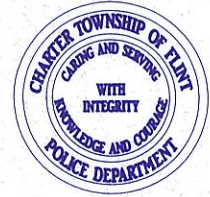




# CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FLINT POLICE DEPARTMENT

To ensure the Flint Township Police Department is able to provide and maintain a consistent level of quality service throughout this pandemic, we will be taking steps to ensure the safety and protection of our staff, as we continue to protect the citizens of our Township.

The Flint Township Police Department will continue to respond to "in-progress" calls and emergencies.

When calling 911, please ensure you provide a call back number whenever possible. Our officers will likely contact you via telephone before arrival to assess the need for an in-person response. For minor reports, Officers will likely provide you with the report number and complete the report without personal interaction.

If an officer does respond, please be prepared to step outside of your home and meet the officer in an open environment. This is consistent with the recommended social distancing to curb the spread of this illness

The hours of the Flint Township Police Department lobby will be changed to Monday – Friday, 8:00am – 2:00pm.
