REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ The charitable or civic organization maintains at least \$500,000 in liability insurance. The insurance carrier must be licensed to do business in the state of Michigan.
- ✓ The person or persons collecting donations must be 18 years of age or older.
- ✓ The person or persons must wear high-visibility safety apparel that meets current American standards promulgated by the International Safety Equipment Association.
- ✓ The portion of the roadway upon which the solicitation occurs is not a work zone
 and is within an intersection where traffic control devices are present.
- ✓ A local government or road authority that has jurisdiction over a roadway upon which solicitation occurs is not liable for any claim for damages arising out of the use of the roadway.
- ✓ Only <u>one</u> charitable or civic organization will be allowed at a time in any road for collections.
- ✓ An application will not be considered if the letter from the IRS granting tax exemption status and a certificate of liability insurance <u>is not</u> provided by the charitable or civic organization.
